Atomic bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki

Hiroshima Day commemorates 6th of August, 1945. On this day, the first Atomic Bomb attack occurred over Hiroshima in Japan. Three days later, on 9th of August, 1945, one more Japanese city, Nagasaki was bombed.

The atomic bombings of the cities of Hiroshima and Nagasaki in Japan were conducted by the United States of America during the final stages of World War II in 1945. The two events are the only use of nuclear weapons in war till date. On August 15, 1945, World War II ended, with the surrender of the Japanese, but at a terrible price.

The Two cities were destroyed and casualties, mostly civilians, were estimated at around 2 Lakh, with many more people dying later from injuries and illness.

Hiroshima Day is now a focus for Anti-war and Anti- Nuclear discussions and demonstrations all over the world.
